Achillea 'Saucy Seduction' (Yarrow)
H: 1.5 to 2 feet, June to August





Aethionema schistosum (Stonecress)
H: 10 to 15 inches, early to mid spring

Agastache 'Blue Fortune' H: 2 to 3 feet, July-Sept



Agastache 'Bolero' H: 1.5 feet, mid-summer to early fall



Antennaria dioica (Common Pussytoes) H: 3 to 9 inches, April to May



Anthemis tinctoria (Golden Marguerite) H: 1 to 3 feet, Summer



Arabis caucasica (Wall Rock Cress) H: 0.5 to 1.5, April, May



Armeria maritima (Common Thrift) H: 0.5 to 1, April, May



Artemisia 'Silvermound' (Wormwood)
H: 10 inches



Asclepias tuberosa (Butterfly Weed) H: 1 to 1.5, June to August, Fall - Seedpods



Aurinia saxatilis (Basket of Gold) H: 0.5 to 1 feet, April, May



Baptisia australis (False Blue Indigo)
H: 3 to 4 feet, May, June, Seed pods later in summer



Centranthus ruber (Red Valerian) H: 1.5 to 3 feet, May, June



Dianthus deltoides (Maiden Pinks)
H: 0.5 to 1 foot, May, June
Some will rebloom if sheared.



Echinops ritro (Globe Thistle)
H: 3 to 4 feet, July to September



Gaillardia X grandiflora (Blanket Flower) H: 2 to 3 feet, June to September



Gaura lindheimeri H: 3 to 5, August to October



Gypsophila paniculata (Baby's Breath) H: 2 to 3 feet, May to August



Lavandula angustifolia 'Hidcote(Common Lavender) H: 1 to 1.5 feet, June to August



Lychnis chalcedonica (Maltese Cross) H: 3 feet, Summer



Oenothera macrocarpa (Ozark Sundrops) H: 0.75 to 1 foot, June to August



Nepeta 'Walker's Low' H: 2 to 2.5 feet, April and again if cut back



Penstemon spp. (Bearded Tongue) H: 1.5 to 3 feet, Late Spring



Perovskia atriplicifolia (Russian Sage) H: 3 to 5 feet, August, September



Rudbeckia fulgida fulgida (Orange Coneflower/ Black-eyed Susan) H: 1 to 2 feet, July to September



Salvia 'May Night'
H: 1.5 to 2, May, June and later if dead headed



Saponaria ocymoides (Rock Soapwort)
H: 6 to 8 inches, Late spring, early summer





Sedum 'Agelina'
H: 4 inches, Bloom insignificant, foliage color best in spring and fall

Thymus serpyllum (Creeping Thyme)
H: 3 inches, June, July





Berberis 'Bagatelle' (Barberry)
H: 1 to 1.5 feet

Caryopteris X clandonensis (Blue Beard) H: 2 to 4 feet, August, September



Cotinus coggygria (Smoke Bush)
H: 10 feet, Smoky spent flowers in summer,
fall color

Heptacodium miconioides (Seven Son Flower)
H: 15 to 20 feet, September, good seed pods
and bark



Potentilla fruticosa (Cinquefoil) H: 2 to 4 feet, June to September



Rosa rugosa 'Purple Pavement' H: 3 to 6 feet, June and repeats
